



Model 119-15 (Aviation Fueling)



The Model 119-15 has a very specific purpose: to limit the flow of fuel through a filter separator, close fully in the event of high water levels in the filter separator sump and close to prevent reverse flow. To perform this task, the Model 119-15 must operate in conjunction with one of the OCV 800 Series interface float pilots.

OPERATION

With little or no water in the sump of the filter separator, the float of the interface pilot is down. The float pilot routes vessel pressure to the bonnet of the three-way auxiliary pilot. This positions the three port auxiliary pilot to connect the bonnet of the main valve downstream, allowing the valve to open. While open, the rate of flow pilot, located in the valve inlet flange, senses the differential across the integral orifice plate and responds to changes in this differential by modulating the main valve to prevent the flow rate from exceeding the predetermined maximum.

With a high water level in the sump of the filter separator, the float of the interface pilot is up. The float pilot vents pressure from the bonnet of the three-way auxiliary pilot, shifting it to apply full inlet pressure to the bonnet of the main valve and drives the valve fully and tightly elegand. tightly closed.

Should outlet pressure exceed inlet pressure, the valve's reverse flow check feature will close the valve.




SIZING

SPECIFICATIONS (Typical Aviation Fueling Application)

The filter separator rate of flow/shut-off/check valve shall open and close via hydraulic signals from the interface float pilot, shall limit the flow rate through the filter separator to a predetermined maximum, and shall prevent reverse flow.

The filter separator rate of flow/shut-off/check valve shall be a single-seated, line pressure operated, diaphragm actuated, pilot controlled globe valve. The valve shall seal by means of a corrosion-resistant seat and a resilient, rectangular seat disc. These, and other parts, shall be replaceable without removing the valve from the line. The stem of the main valve shall be guided top and bottom by integral bushings. Alignment of the body, bonnet and diaphragm assembly shall be by precision dowel prins. The diaphragm shall not be used as a seating surface, nor shall the pistons be used as an operating means. The pilot system shall be furnished complete and installed on the main valve. It shall include an orifice plate mounted in the valve inlet flange, rate of flow control pilot, inline strainer, 3way auxiliary pilot, and valve position indicator. The filter separator rate of flow/shut-off/check valve shall be operationally and hydrostatically tested prior to shipment.

MATERIALS OF CONSTRUCTION

The main valve body and bonnet shall be ductile iron. All ferrous surfaces shall be coated with 4 mils of epoxy. The main valve seat ring shall be stainless steel. Elastomers (diaphragms, resilient seats and O-rings) shall be Buna-N. The control pilots, control line tubing and fittings shall be stainless

OPERATING CONDITIONS

The filter separator rate of flow/shut-off/check valve shall be suitable for pressures of $\langle X \rangle$ by at flow rates up to <X> gpm.

ACCEPTABLE PRODUCTS

The filter separator rate of flow/shut-off/check valve shall be a <size> Model 119-15, <globe pattern, angle pattern>, with <150# flanged, 300# flanged> end connections, as manufactured by OCV Control Valves, Tulsa, Oklahoma, USA.


For maximum efficiency, the OCV control valve should be mounted in a piping system so that the valve bonnet (cover) is in the top position. Other positions are acceptable but may not allow the valve to function to its fullest and safest potential. In particular, please consult the factory before installing 8" and larger valves, or any valves with a limit switch, in positions other than described. Space should be taken into consideration when mounting valves and their pilot systems.

A routine inspection & maintenance program should be established and conducted yearly by a qualified technician. Consult our factory @ 1-888-628-8258 for parts and service.
